COW'S EYE dissection page 6 Now take a look at the rest of the eye. If the vitreous humor is still in the eyeball, empty it out. On the inside of the back half of the eyeball, you can see some blood vessels that are part of a thin fleshy film. That film is the retina.

Eye Anatomy

On the posterior side of the eye, nestled in the fat and muscle tissue, there is a noticeably round protuberance that feels stiffer than the surrounding tissue.
