A run-on sentence occurs when two or more independent clauses (also known as complete sentences) are connected improperly.. Example: I love to write papers I would write one every day if I had the time.. There are two complete sentences in the above example: Sentence 1: I love to write papers. Sentence 2: I would write one every day if I had the time.

A sentence can be a simple two word clause or a several clause compound sentence. As long as it contains a main clause it is considered a complete sentence.

A complete sentence must have two essential parts: a subject and a verb. A subject is a noun (a person, place, thing, or idea) that tells us what the sentence is about. A subject tells us 'who' or 'what.' The verb is the action of the subject, or it may be a linking verb.

Rule Five Set off long introductory dependent clauses and phrases (four or more words) with a comma. These clauses and phrases do not include the subject and verb of the sentence, and they cannot stand alone as complete sentences.
