Typically external documents are recorded on a document register that includes much of the same information gathered for internal documents; e.g. document name, revision history, document location and so on.

External documents must be determined and surveilled. A QMS must determine what the relevant documents of external origin are. For example, an organization can use a register that, for each relevant document, can list: name of the document, issuer of the document, updated version and date, internal distribution (who inside the organization use the document), and responsibility for control (who inside the organization is responsible for controlling).
