Keep in mind that with a large number of tests, even 8/10 could allow several apparent positives in support of false hypotheses so only 10/10 or 9/10 should be used to support a hypothesis. They need to understand it is not about which team "won" this time, hypothesis testing is about whether that team will (almost) always win.

Hypothesis testing is the process that an analyst uses to test a statistical hypothesis. The methodology employed by the analyst depends on the nature of the data used and the reason for the analysis.

Central Limit Theorem: States that with a large enough sample, the sample mean will be normally distributed. A normally distributed sample mean is necessary to apply the t-test, so if you are planning to perform a statistical analysis of experimental data, it's important to have a sufficiently large sample.; Conclusion: Determination of whether the hypothesis should be accepted or rejected.
