To support an intending immigrant and his/her family members, the sponsor(s) must generally show that their income level is above 125% of the U.S. poverty line for the family unit. For example, as shown by the 2018 guidelines below, for an immigrant family of 2, the sponsor's income must be at least 20,575 in most states and U.S. territories except Alaska and Hawaii, which have higher income ...

The HHS has the authority to update the poverty guidelines under Federal statute (see 42 U.S.C. 9902(2)). The USCIS will update the Form I-864P, HHS Poverty Guidelines for Affidavit of Support, to reflect the new poverty guidelines. As we noted, the HHS poverty guidelines are relevant to immigration law in the public charge and fee waiver contexts.
