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Valuation For Mergers And Acquisitions

In mergers and acquisitions transactions, this method is used to determine the enterprise value by estimating future cash flows over the horizon period (explained later), calculating the terminal value at the end of that period, then the forecasted free cash flows and terminal value are discounted to the present value of the company's weighted average cost of capital.
